Announcement of Confirmed Covid-19 Case in OHTORI (THAILAND) CO.,LTD.

On July 29th (Thu.), we were informed that a staff of OHTORI (THAILAND) CO.,LTD., one of our affiliates, has infected with Covid-19. We are fully mobilized in handling the situation and collaborating with the related organizations in order to secure safety of our partners and employees, prevent spread of infection, and continue our business.

1. Summary

July 27th (Tue.) A staff of OHTORI (THAILAND) CO.,LTD. left the work early due to mild fever.

July 28th (Wed.) The staff took a PCR test. Meanwhile, remote work is implemented for the rest of the staff members.

July 29th (Thu.) The staff received a positive test result on PCR.

July 29th (Thu.) The Department of Health in MOPH identified one of the staff members as a close contact of the patient.

2. Current status and request related to business

① July 29th (Thu.) Disinfection of the office was executed.

② July 30th (Fri.) The close contact staff received a negative test result on PCR.

③ We have returned to normal business operations.

※We kindly ask for your understanding of respecting human rights and privacy of the patient and their family members.

3. Countermeasures

We are committed to prevent the infection and continue to take effective measures such as washing and sanitizing hands, wearing masks, regular sanitizing of areas workers may touch, introducing flexible work hours, measuring body temperature before work, limiting domestic and overseas business travels, and replacing face-to-face meetings with online meetings.
